GDANSK

Every hour, from the impressive St. Marys basilica, you can hear a Hejnal Mariacki. It is a tune played on a trumpet.

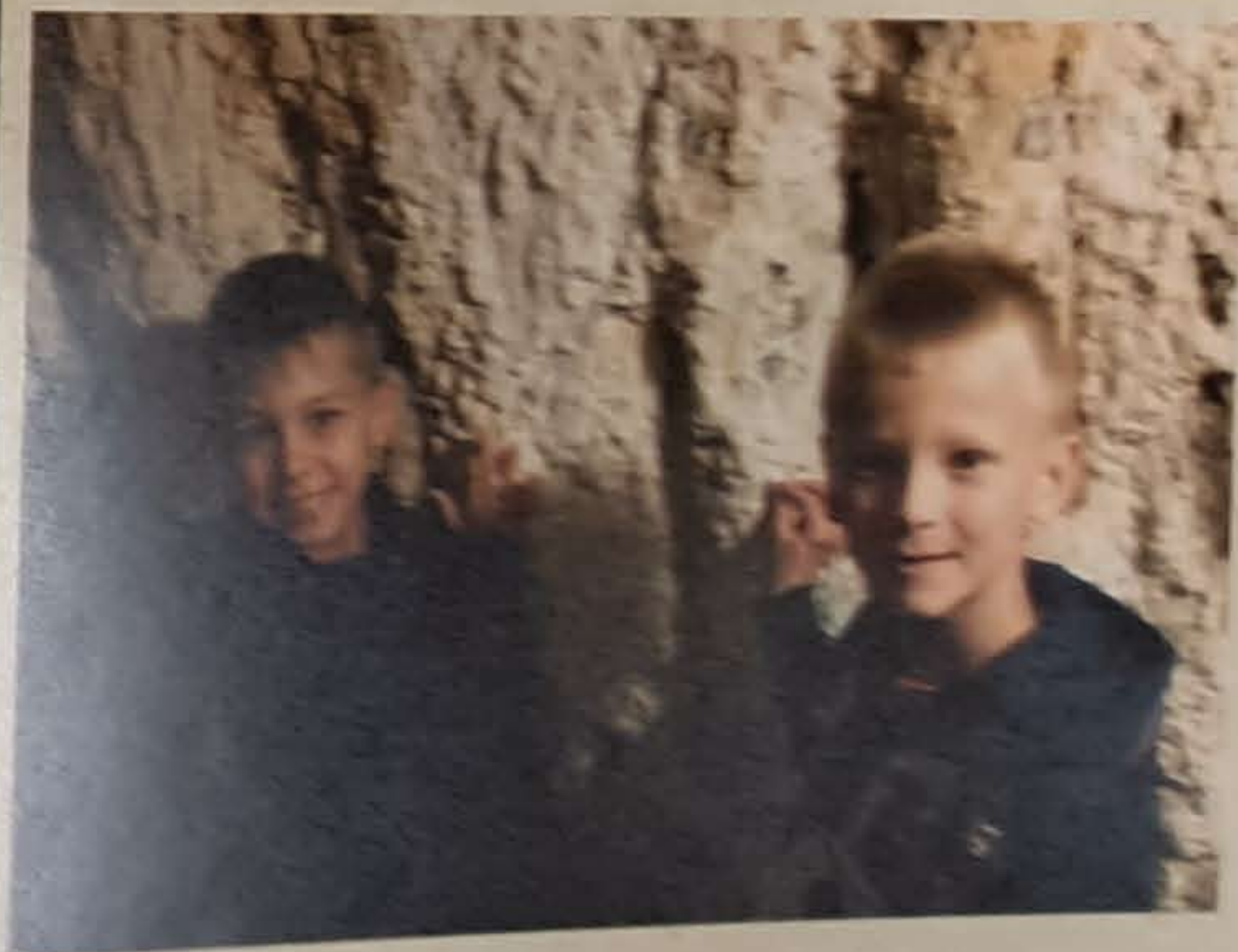


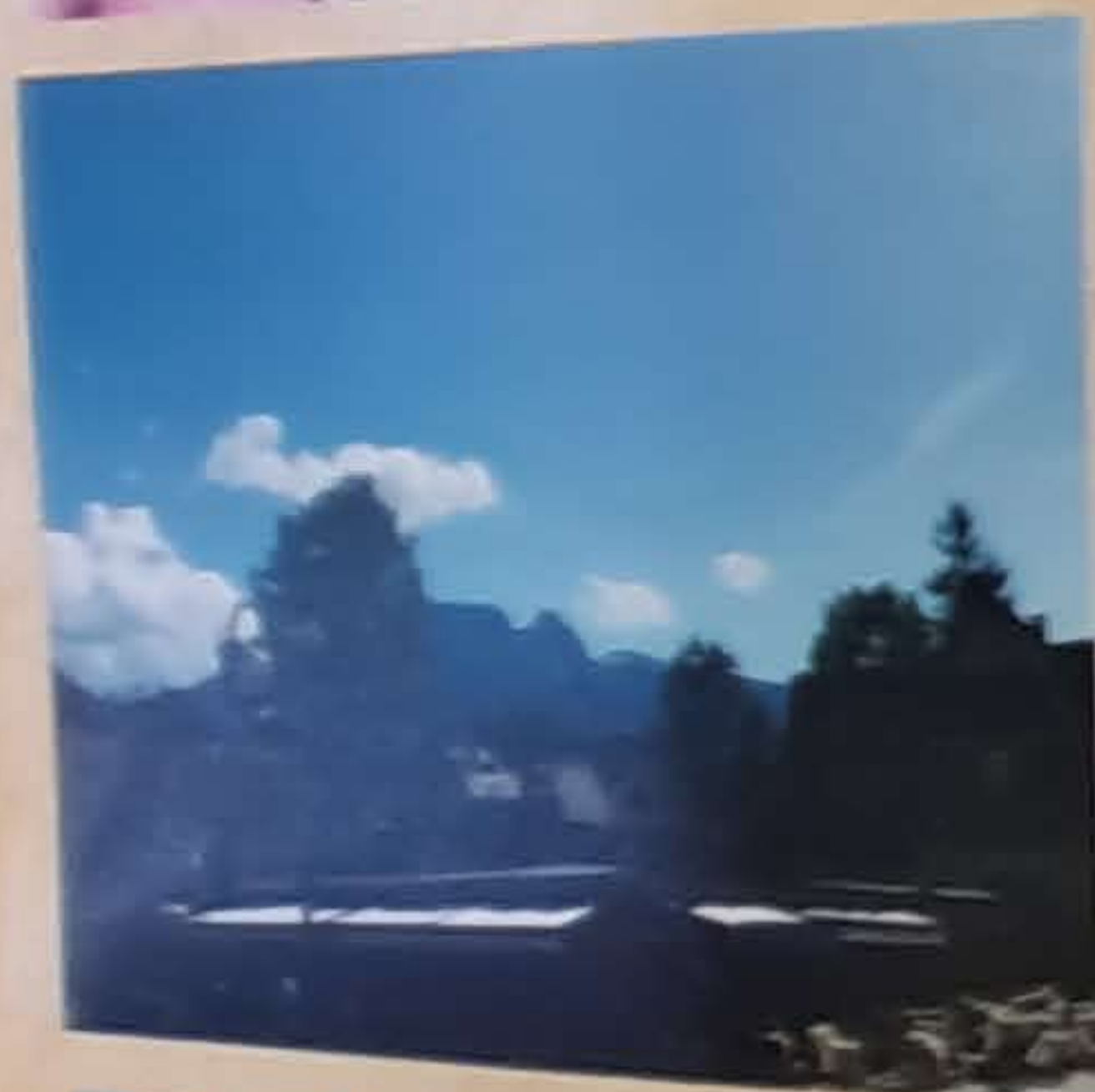


WIELICZKA

While taking a tour, you will have to be very observant, and only then you will see lots of little Gothic figures.

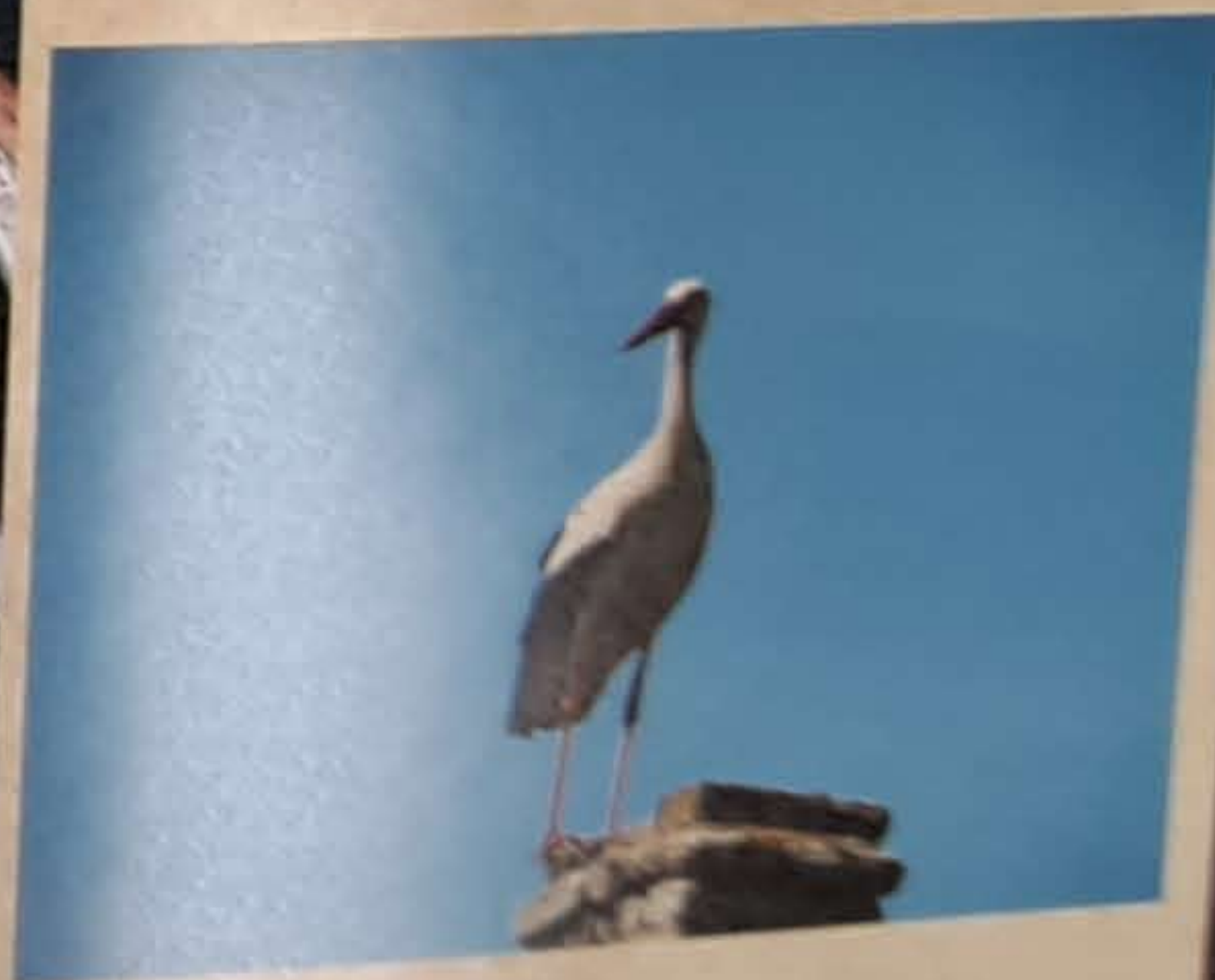
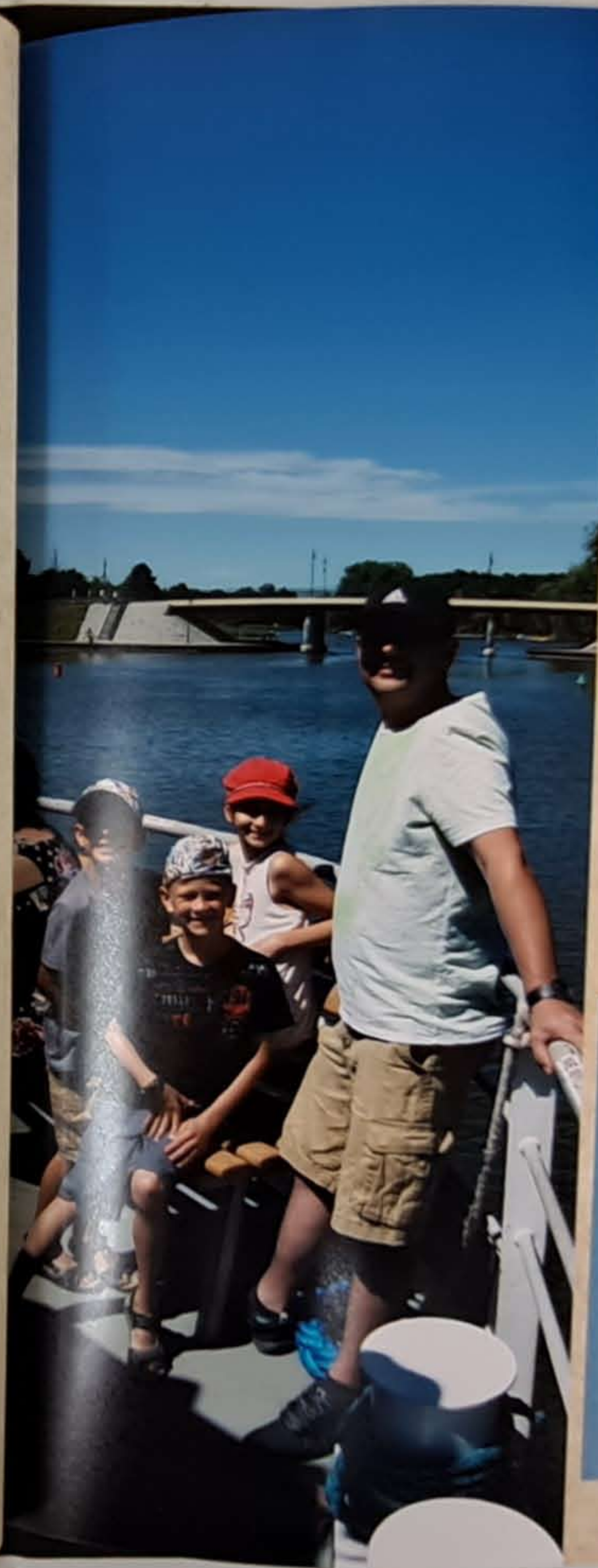




AUGUSTOW

You can find one in Warsaw!

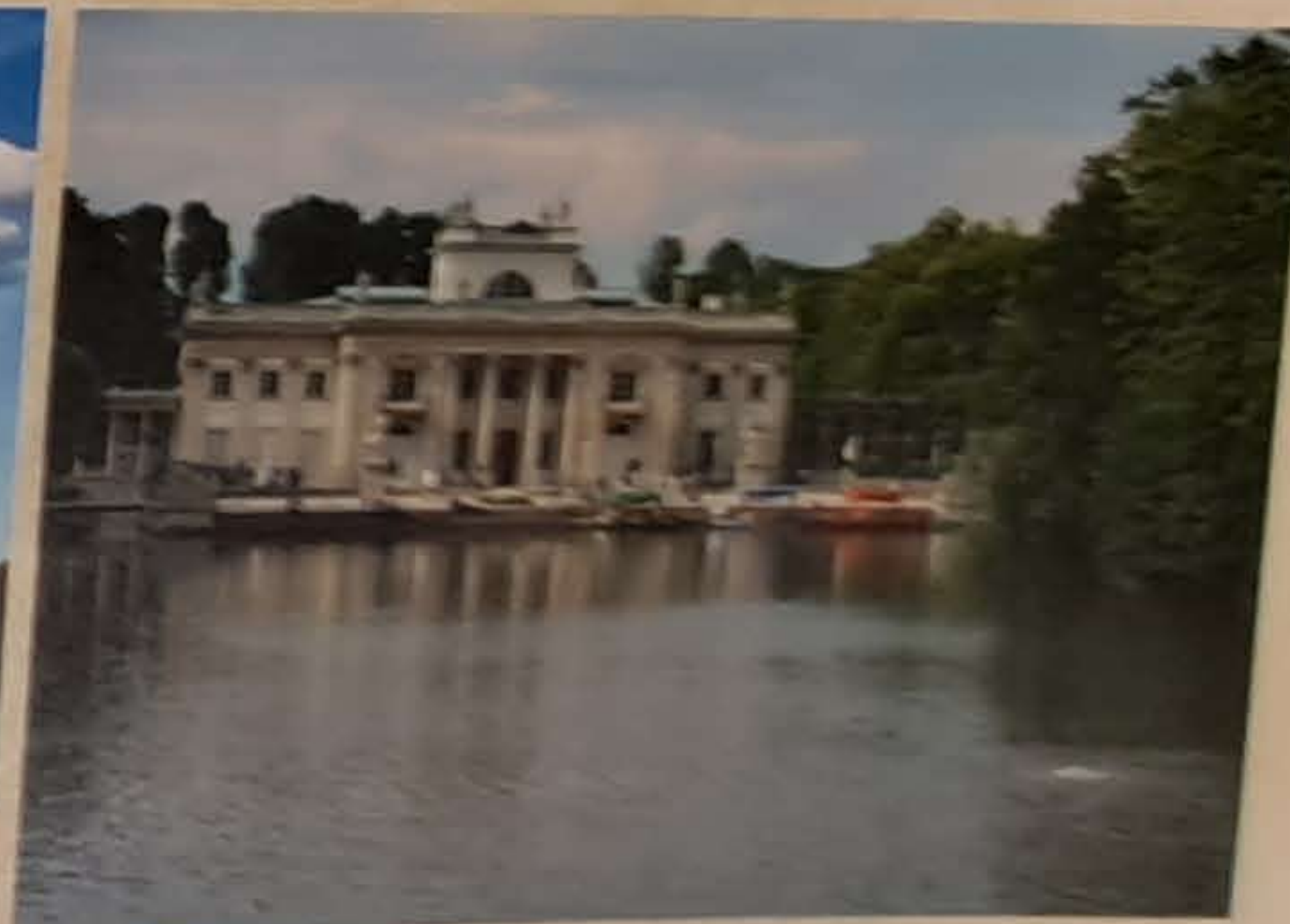
